MAIN INITIATIVES DEBATED UPON

1. Objectives:

- Promote active citizenship among project target groups (e.g. initiatives focused on volunteering associations for senior citizens, University of the Third Age);
- Promote the involvement of citizens in the organisation of network events so to strengthen their sense of belonging to a broader EU community.

2. Actions:

- Small scale infrastructure interventions – for increased accessibility for project target groups;
- Promote cultural and know-how exchanges between GEMS communities, including their new residents (e.g. cooking festival and promotion of typical products; exchange of best practices in renewable energy production, etc);
- Promote cooperation between local alpine actors and larger communities (i.e. urban settlements).
